

**Minutes of the Saint Paul Town Council Meeting
Held Febraury 4, 2025 in Civic Center**

The meeting was called to order by Timothy Ray @ 7:00 PM

Roll Call

Council Members Joshua Sangl, Tim Ray and Kim Livingston were present along with Clerk/Treasurer Alyssa Hall, Town Marshall Josh Kuntz, Gym/Civic Center Rentals Richard Rampley, Volunteer Fire Dept. Dan Pennington and Water/Sewer Operator Les Day were present for reporting. Comcast employees along with Ben from Shelby County highway dept.

Timothy Ray welcomed the public and opened the meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The minutes of the board meeting held January 14, 2024, were presented for approval. Kim Livingston made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Tim Ray seconded the motion, the motion was put to a vote and the motion was carried.

TOWN MARSHALL (Josh Kuntz reporting on the month of January)

Josh had 80 hours, Joey Roberts 9 hours and Austin Fleener 69.5 hours.

Austin had 336 miles roundtrip for training, PD asked for him to be reimbursed for mileage. Council agreed to reimbursed at a federal rate of .70 Cents per mile.

Police Dept. requested updated computers and cameras for 2 of the patrol cars, submitted quotes. Council aged all in Favor to update the technology in 2 patrol cars, funded from 2240 public safety.

Police Dept asking to update the tasers theirs being expired and needing replaced, submitted quotes.

Presented the Adams township contract for the town president to sign, Josh will review and will sign off at next months board meeting.

GYM/CIVIC CENTER RENTALS (Richard Ramley reporting on the month of January)

- 1 rental at the civic center
- Resolution 2025 3 to accept a transfer of real property was presented and read by Josh Sangl regarding the purchase of the Saint Paul gymnasium, no questions from the council members, along with no questions from the public, closed commenting to the public, reopened to the council members no additional comments. A motion to sustain the rules and pass on a single reading, Kim Livingston made a motion to sustain the rules and pass on a single reading, Tim Ray and Josh Sangl seconded the motion. The motion was put to a vote and the motion was carried.
- 1 of the 2 hanging gas furnaces went out at the gym, the primary one is still working, Richard is going to reach out for quotes on updating the systems there.

WATER/SEWER OPERATOR (Les Day reporting on the month of January)

- Crenshaw Street- material quotes to replace the ¾ inch line, Les to get quotes for labor.
- Update from Stephen Brock on the rate study, C/T sent all reports to Stephen, waiting on him to send us his findings.
- Well meter to be installed.
- Update on the sewer blockage from last summer.

- Comcast asking about permits for installing broadband fiber on the shelby county side of Saint Paul. Ben with the shelby county highway department shared the ordinance how they handle similar situations- Council to get back with comcast after adopting an ordinance on the matter.
- Reviewed the compliant engagemnet report regarding State Board of Accounts audit for the years of 2019-2023 and opened up questions to the public
- 2nd reading and passing of the Ordinance 2025 1 Prohibiting Dumping of Solid Waste. Comments were open to council and public. Tim Ray made a motion to pass the ordinance as read, Kim Livingston and Josh Sangl seconded the motion. The motion was put to a vote and the motion was carried.
- 2nd reading and passing of the Ordinance 2025 2 Removal of Unsafe Buildings Within the Town of Saint Paul, Indiana Comments were open to council and public. Tim Ray made a motion to pass the ordinance as read, Kim Livingston and Josh Sangl seconded the motion. The motion was put to a vote and the motion was carried.


