**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF ST PAUL, INDIANA ADOPTING THE  
DECATUR COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS the Town of St Paul recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Town of St Paul; and

WHEREAS the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Decatur County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS the Decatur County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the Town of St Paul from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Town Council of St Paul demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Decatur County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1. The St Paul Town Council adopts the Decatur County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. While content related to the Town of St Paul may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the St Paul Town Council to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
