RESOLUTION NO. 2024-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL ADOPTING THE 2023 SHELBY COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the TOWN COUNCIL OF ST. PAUL recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the TOWN OF ST. PAUL; and

WHEREAS, the SHELBY COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2023 SHELBY COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 SHELBY COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in SHELBY COUNTY from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the TOWN OF ST. PAUL demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2023 SHELBY COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL, STATE OF INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with Ind. Code § 36-1-4-11, the TOWN OF ST. PAUL adopts the 2023 SHELBY COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN. While content related to SHELBY COUNTY may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the TOWN OF ST. PAUL to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
