**RESOLUTION COMMITTING TO THE GOAL OF ZERO TRAFFIC DEATHS AND  
SUPPORTING PARTICIPATION IN THE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY  
ACTION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) Federal Highway Association (FHWA) has established the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Program to support local initiatives that prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries; and

WHEREAS, the Future 3 Safety Action Plan Committee representing Rush, Decatur, and Henry Counties are leading this effort to create coordinated county-wide safety action plans; and


WHEREAS, these safety action plans will identify priority areas of concern and outline strategies to reduce and ultimately eliminate roadway fatalities and serious injuries throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this resolution by all incorporated communities is required to comply with the SS4A program guidelines and to ensure full participation in the county's planning process; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED by the Town of Saint Paul Council of Saint Paul, Indiana, that:


